The gist: Opening tomorrow, Epicurean Group, the folks behind hit Village restaurants [Dell'anima](#), [L'Artusi](#) and [L'Apicio](#) (recently featured on Bravo's *Best New Restaurant*), will open Alta Linea at [The High Line Hotel](#) in Chelsea, a seasonal outdoor eatery located on the hotel's front courtyard and garden.

The drinks: The cocktail menu by owner/partner and wine guru Joe Campanale will highlight the Italian aperitivo tradition, featuring cocktails like frozen negronis and the Isola Privata, made with tequila, watermelon, Cocchi Rosa and Dolin Blanc, among others.
