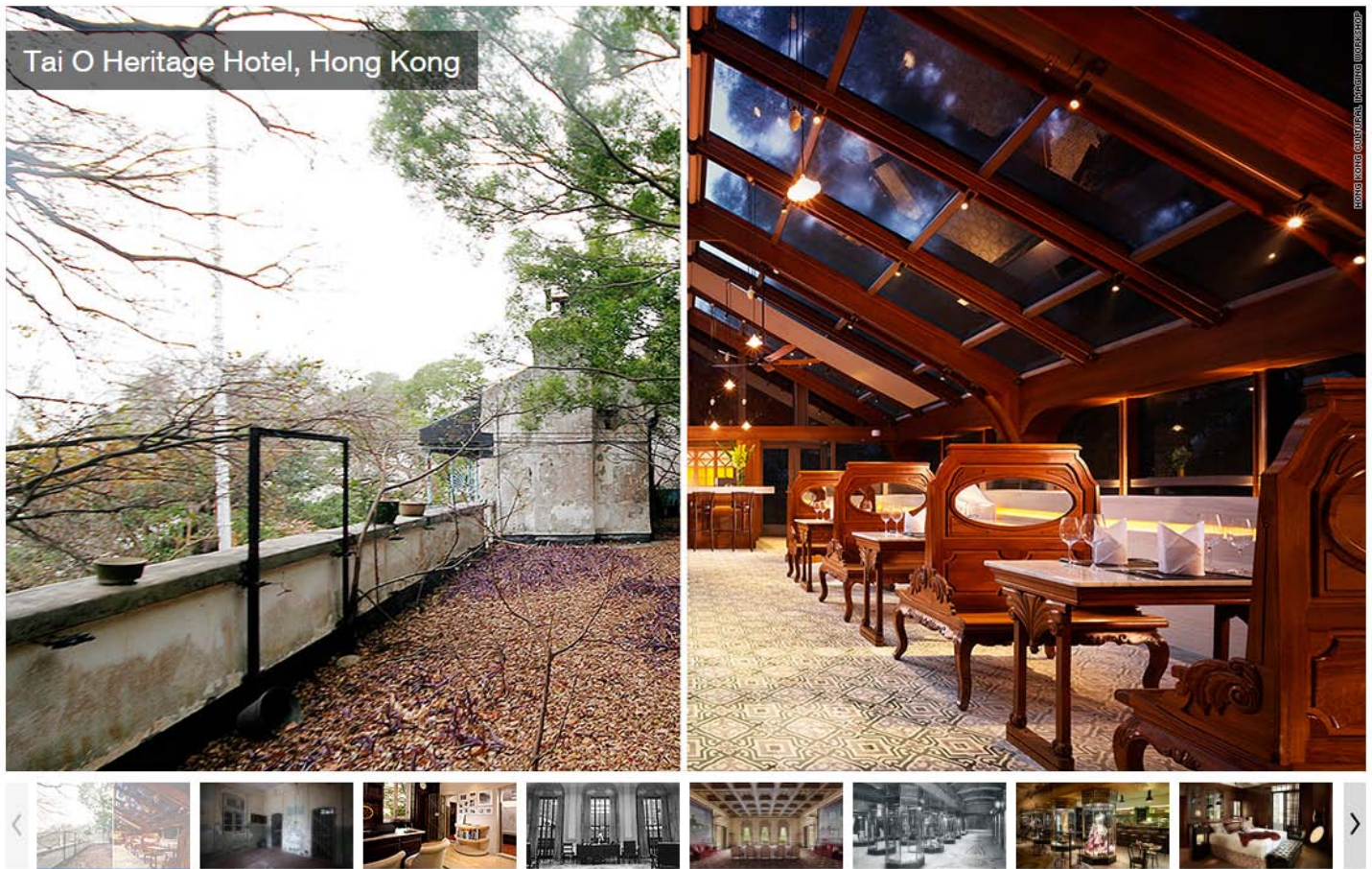

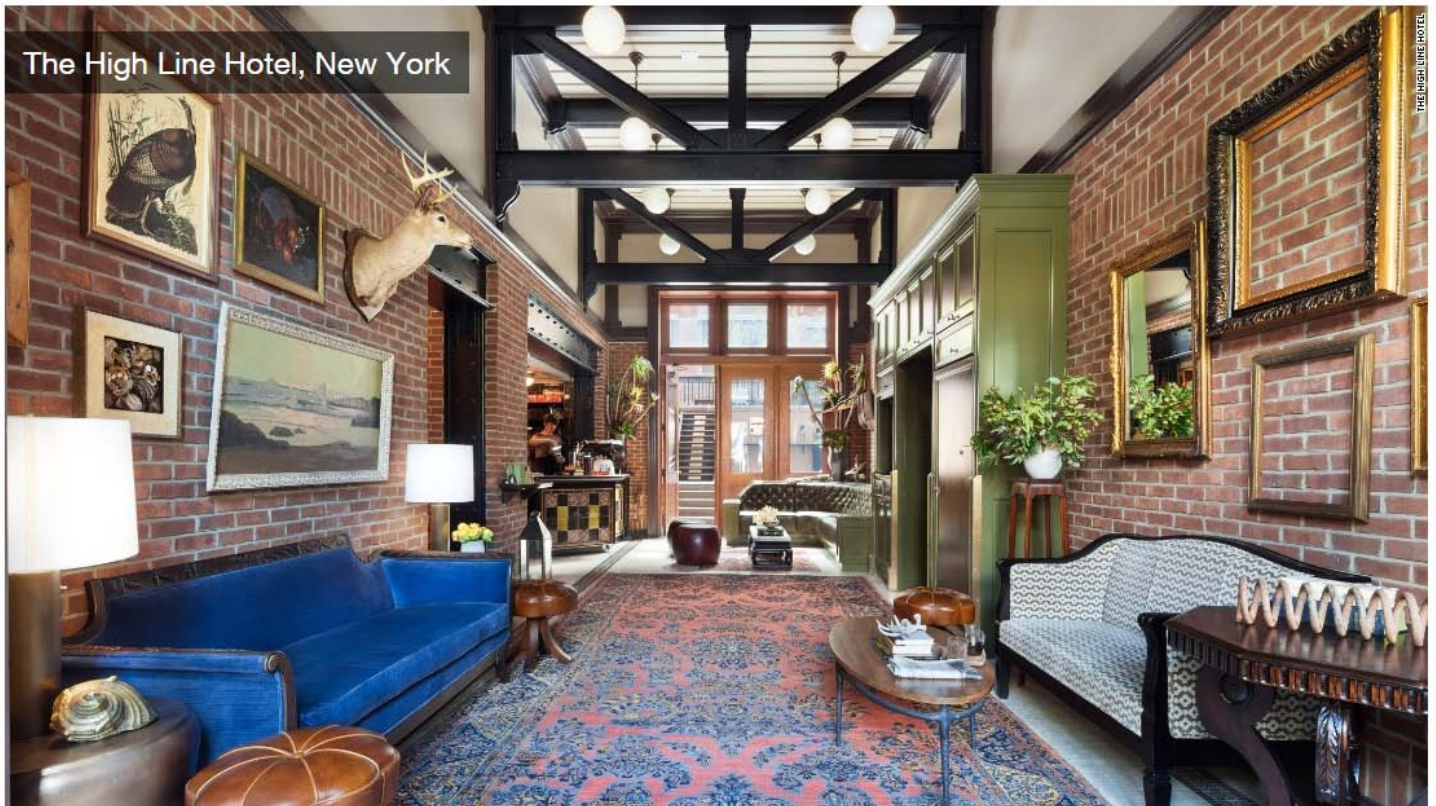
Located in the historical neighborhood of Chelsea, **The High Line Hotel** was once the General Theological Seminary, built in 1895.
